

# Eezy-Peezy Shrug

A *Lau*original, by Laura L Yona

## Measurements

- Center back to hem = 13"
- Width from cuff to cuff = 26"

## Gauge

2.5-3st/in. Due to the construction of the garment gauge is not terrifically important – if you're off, your shrug will be slightly shorter/longer and the sleeves will be slightly shorter/longer. Obviously, you can choose to knit at a different gauge than the one given in order to facilitate that.

## Materials

- Size 11 32 or 40" circular needles
- Size 11 DPNs (optional)
- Lisa Souza Max (Sample is knit in Vert de Gris) – 2 skeins (438 yds)

## Pattern

CO 165. Work 3x3 rib (k3, p3) for 12 rows. Next row, begin st st. Continue st st until total height is 13". BO loosely.

You should now have a rectangle of fabric. Lay the rectangle on a flat surface, right side up. Following Fig 1 below, fold corner A to point 1 and corner B to point 2 (there should be 8 inches between the two points). You should end up with something that looks like Fig 2 below, where the red lines are your fold lines. Pin where the two edges meet and sew each side together from the front (inside) corner to the back (outside) corner. You should have a 4" hole that will serve as the sleeve.

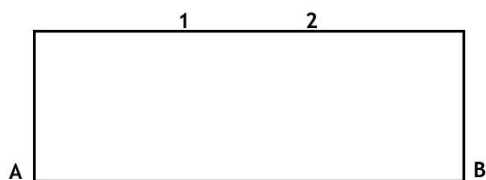

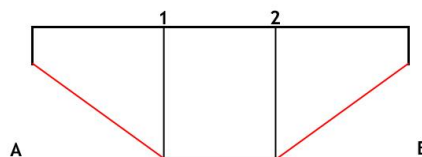

Pick up 42 st evenly around each sleeve and using DPNs, Magic Loop, or other method of your choice, work 12 rounds of 3x3 rib. BO loosely in pattern. Weave in all ends.

You can either fold the cuffs up as I have done (I recommend sewing them to the sleeves if you do), or leave them folded down for a longer sleeve.
