

Toddler Twist *A Lauriginal* from Laura L Yona



Materials:

1 ball Mission Falls 136 Merino Superwash (136 yds - I had app. 7 yards undoubled leftover)
Size 11 needles (You will need needles to accommodate your preferred method of working a small circular circumference - I used Magic Loop, but DPNs or two circs will work fine)

Gauge: 5 st = 1" in 3x2 rib

Finished size: Will fit toddler, child, or small-headed adult (it's very stretchy)

Abbreviations:

CF3 = place 3 knit st on cable needle and hold to the front. K3, k3 from cable needle

k = knit

k2tog = knit 2 stitches together

p = purl

p2tog = purl 2 stitches together

pss0 = pass slipped stitch over

sl1 = slip one stitch

ssk = slip one stitch, slip the next stitch, knit both stitches together

T3L = place 3 knit stitches on a cable needle and hold to the front, p1, k3 st from cable needle

T3R = place one purl stitch on a cable needle and hold to the back, k3, p1 st from cable needle



Instructions:

Cast on 60 st. Join. Work as follows:

R1-4: *k3, p2. Rep * to end.

R5: *k3, p2, T3L, T3R, p2. Rep * to end.

R6: *k3, p3, CF3, p3. Rep * to end.

R7: *k3, p2, T3R, T3L, p2. Rep * to end.

R8-24: *k3, p2. Rep * to end.

R25: *k1, ssk, p2, k2tog, k1, p2. Rep * to end.

R26: Work even.

R27: *k2, p2tog. Rep * to end.

R28: *k2tog, p1. Rep * to end.

R29: *ssk. Rep * to end.

R30: *ssk, k2tog. Rep * to end.

R31: [Sl 1, k2tog, pss0] twice

R32: k2tog

Note: Hat is worked with yarn held double. I recommend working from both the outside and inside of the ball, but you can try winding into two separate balls if that's your thing.

Cut yarn and thread tail through remaining stitch, pulling tight. Weave ends in.
